

# Story Collage Project

## Materials Required:

magazines  
computer graphics  
scissors  
Fiskar scissors  
glue  
markers or colored pencils  
construction/wrapping paper  
miscellaneous items  
environmental print



## Directions:

- Search through magazines, computer clip-art, environmental print, photo copied images, or hand drawn pictures that illustrate the following story elements: title, author, setting, characters, plot, main events, problem & solution, and theme of the book.
- Search through magazines, computer clip-art, environmental print, photo copied images, or hand drawn pictures that illustrate the personal and physical attributes of the main characters.
- Choose graphics to “retell” the story. Choose words or phrases as captions to help provide detailed information for the pictures.
- You may cut construction or wrapping paper as a background frame for your phrases and pictures. Use Fiskar scissors to cut decorative borders.
- Overlap the pictures, on a cardboard background such as a pizza round, to create a collage effect. Glue pictures to the background.
- Miscellaneous items may be added to give the collage a 3-D effect. (rickrack, ribbon, yarn, stickers, beads etc.)
- Write a story summary or explanation of each item. Glue summary to the backside of the cardboard background.
